Board Matters

- 1. The Board welcomed Grant Hansen as a Director (Taungurung Lands and Waters Aboriginal Corporation). The Board also welcomed Perry Wandin (Wurundjeri Woiwurrung Cultural Heritage Aboriginal Corporation).
- 2. The Board reviewed and approved the Federation's Strategic Plan, noting next steps for communicating and implementing the direction.
- 3. The board considered and discussed an initial scoping document on the future options development for governance structures, with a view to working with the subcommittees further on this.
- 4. The Board noted the First Peoples' Assembly resolution and potential implications for Traditional Owner recognition and representational structures in Victoria, noting that a further meeting was being convened for discussion on the matter in more depth.
